**Jannah - Gr 5/6**

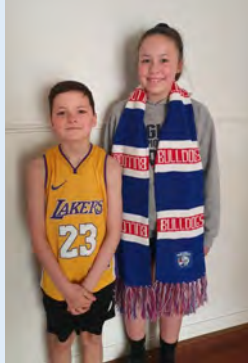
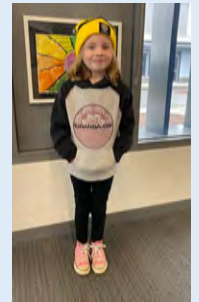
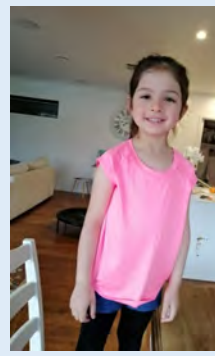
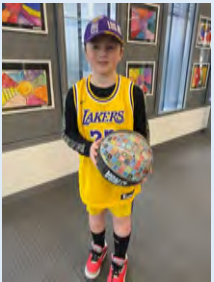
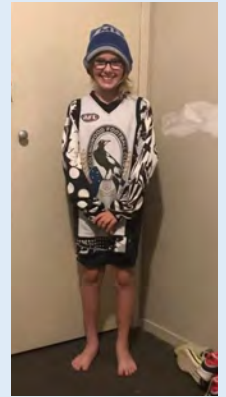
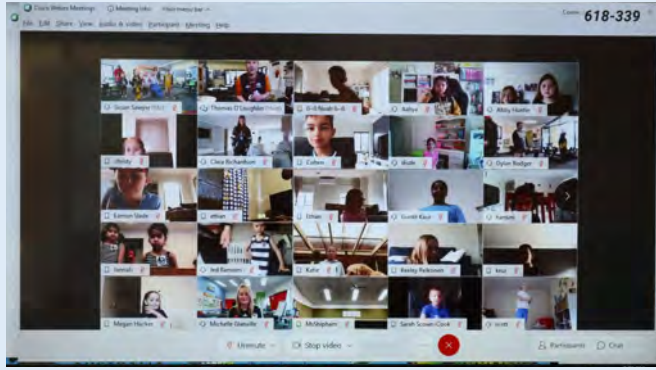
